LE P'TIT QUINQUIN IS A SONG BY ALEX DESROUSSEAU (1820-1892), WRITTEN IN 1853 IN A DIALECT FROM NORTHERN FRANCE. THIS SONG HAS BEEN SUNG FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PARIS, 2 YEARS LATER. AT THE ORIGIN, THIS SONG WAS A LULLABY (A QUINQUIN IS A CHILD), IT WILL BECOME THE SYMBOL OF THE COME BACK OF THIS DIALECT. MOREOVER, IT WILL EVEN BECOME THE SONG



OF OUR SOLDIERS LEAVING THE NORTH OF FRANCE FOR THE FRANCO-PRUSSIAN WAR. NOWADAYS, IT'S KIND OF THE UNOFFICIAL ANTHEM OF THE CITY OF LILLE. ARTISANALLY MADE WITH THE TOP QUALITY PRODUCTS OF OUR AREA, THE P'TIT QUINQUIN LEMONADE HONOUR THE NORTHERN FRANCE POPULATION.
